South Side Park Survey Will Help Choose Amenities for Future Park

November 18, 2014 (Siloam Springs, Ark.) Parks and Recreation staff and the Advisory Board are looking for input from residents about what amenities to put in the future South Side Park located on Lake Francis Drive just east of Mt. Olive. The site is formerly the Rosebud Trailer Park Lot, which has been cleared and prepped for the Park.

On Monday, November 17th residents and businesses within a one-mile radius of the future park were contacted with a phone survey through SiloamAlert. Approximately 744 phones answered the survey. While participation was lower than expected, residents will have another chance to give feedback. "This is a significant investment for the City and we want to make sure we use the money wisely.
