Siloam Springs District Court offers Warrant Amnesty Program

February 4, 2014 (Siloam Springs, Ark.) The Siloam Springs District Court, in cooperation with the Siloam Springs Police Department, is offering a **warrant amnesty program** for defendants with outstanding warrants in this court only. The program is available **February 17th through March 31st**, 2015. During this time, the court offices will be open Monday through Thursday, 8:00 am to 4:00 pm and will extend hours of operation Fridays from 8:00 am to 6:00 pm.

While the program is in effect, the District Court will waive **some fees and jail time if the original charge is paid in full**. Certain cases may require a court appearance date. Only cash or money orders may be used to pay off the warrant. Defendants are encouraged to call the court for the amounts owed and for answers to any questions about the program. In addition, if the defendant's driver's license has been suspended due to the issuance of the warrant, a court order will be issued to lift the suspension.

We are offering this opportunity to assist defendants with their payments, give them the opportunity to regain valid driving status and alleviate their fear in having an arrest warrant issued against them. The Siloam Springs Police Department has plans to conduct a "warrant round up" shortly after this program ends.
