

YARD WASTE COLLECTION

The Solid Waste Department collects bagged grass clippings and leaves. These items should be placed in a secured garbage bag and set by the curb **on your trash day by 7:00 a.m.**

The Sanitation Dept picks up brush, including tree limbs, once a month by zone (see below).

Brush is to be placed at the curb if possible and **must be out by Monday morning.**


1st Monday NE section of town

2nd Monday SE section of town

3rd Monday NW section of town

4th Monday SW section of town

The City is divided by Jefferson, running East and West, and Mt. Olive, running North and South.



HELPFUL RECYCLING HINTS

- 1) Flatten cardboard, plastic, tin, and aluminum cans if you need more room in the bin.



- 2) **Rinse all containers.** It's okay to leave paper labels on plastic bottles and cans.



- 3) Recycle only rinsed plastic bottles and jugs, with necks. Please remove and discard lids.



- 4) Please use your recycle bin lid on rainy or windy days to keep your recyclables dry and safe from blowing away.



- 5) Make sure your recycle bin is out by the curb by 7:00 a.m. on your recycling day.

Solid Waste and Recycling

The City of Siloam Springs offers weekly curbside residential trash collection. Voluntary curbside recycling is also offered at no additional charge.

Dumpster rental rates and information are available by calling, 524-8512.

For a fee, households and businesses may bring their trash to the Transfer Station located at 1108 E. Ashley.

Transfer Station/Drop-Off Hours:

Mon. - Fri. 8:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m.

Saturday 9:00 a.m. - 12:00 p.m.

All recycling, including glass, can be taken, free of charge, to the Transfer Station/Recycling Drop-Off Center during regular business hours.

CURBSIDE RECYCLING

To learn how to receive a free recycling bin please call 524-8512.

Items for curbside collection include:

Aluminum Cans / Steel or Tin Cans



Paper includes: Newspapers / Magazines / Phone Books / Junk Mail / Office Paper / School Paper



Plastic Bottles (must be a bottle or jug with a neck that is smaller than the body of the container)



Cardboard boxes, including cereal boxes, Kleenex boxes, paper towel tubes, etc...



***Glass is not collected curbside but is accepted at the Recycling Drop-Off Center, located at 1108 East Ashley.**

Place recycle bin at least five feet from your curbside trash. It will be emptied each week on your trash day.

Zone 1 is collected on Monday.

Zone 2 is collected on Tuesday.

Zone 3 is collected on Wednesday.

Zone 4 is collected on Thursday.

The Benton County Solid Waste District's Satellite Convenience Center is open Tuesday and Thursday, 8 a.m. to 3 p.m. & every 3rd Saturday, 9 a.m. to 12 p.m. at the Transfer Station. For quantity limits, please visit the website at www.siloamsprings.com
