



BASKETBALL 2018: GENERAL INFORMATION

- There will be two leagues this year: Men's Open and Men's Church/Industrial.
- The open league will be played on Monday nights.
- The church/industrial league will be played on Tuesday nights.
- All league games will be played at the Siloam Springs Intermediate School.
- The season starts the week of January 8th.
- Cost for each league: \$350.00 / team.
- Captains will be allowed to pick jersey colors in the order that their fees are paid in full and registration packets are turned in.
- Teams MUST have matching team jersey's/t-shirts with a number that is easily read.
- Team rosters and fees are due by Friday, December 29th at 5:00 P.M. to the Parks and Recreation office located at 401 West University Street.

Siloam Springs Parks & Recreation Basketball Rules

1. The league is open to players 16 years and older. Current high school, college, and professional players are ineligible. ("Current" means the player was on an official team roster this academic year.)
2. Rosters are limited to 11 players.
3. A player may not play on 2 teams in the same league, but may play in different leagues.
4. Church/Industrial teams may not have more than 4 guys on their roster that play in the Open league.
5. Recreational/Church teams cannot have more than 2 Open league players on the court at any given time. Failure to follow this rule will result in the team taking a forfeit.
6. Each player will be allowed 5 personal fouls.
7. A team must have at least 4 players at game time. A team must always have at least 4 eligible players to continue a game. Otherwise, it is a forfeit.
8. A player will be ineligible to play if alcohol is on his/her breath and will be asked to leave the premises. He/she will not be able to play in the following two games.
9. Teams must wear the same color jerseys with numbers on either the front or back, or both.
10. Games consist of two 20-minute halves with a running clock except during the last 2 minutes of the second half. The clock will stop the last two minutes of the game on a time-out, out-of-bounds, foul, free throw, etc. If a team is up by 15 points or more in the last two minutes, the clock will continue to run.
11. Each team has 2 time-outs per half that do not carry over to the next half. One additional time out is given for overtime play. (If a team has a time-out left from the second-half, they may use it during the overtime play.)
12. If the score is tied after regulation play, a maximum of two 3-minute quarters will be played to determine a winner. If the score is still tied after the extended periods, the 5 players on the court at the final horn from each team will shoot alternating free throws to determine the winner. If the score is still tied after the free throws, one player from each team will alternate free throws until a winner is determined.
13. No dunking/ hanging on the rim/net is allowed. A technical foul and \$25.00 fine will be issued for the violation.
14. Players are not allowed to slap the backboard unless it is contacted while trying to block a shot. Referees will give a technical foul if they believe it was slapped for a reason other than defensive.
15. When a player receives a technical foul, that player must sit out the rest of the current game and the next game unless it is in the last five minutes of the game then the player sits out the following two games.
16. If a player receives a second technical foul in the season, he is out for the rest of the season.
17. Profanity of any kind will not be tolerated. Players and fans will be asked to leave the facility.
18. Fighting or attempting to fight before, during, or after the game, will result in that player being ejected for the rest of the season and the following season.
19. Any harassment by fans or players toward the referees will result in a forfeit by that team and may result in an ejection of that team for the season.
20. Games will begin on time. No grace period will be given.
