Item E1. Final Plat Development Permit, FP20-05, 2200 Block of North Hico Street. Ben briefed the staff-approved item. This item will go to the Board of Directors on July 21<sup>st</sup>, 2020. Ben advised the commission the August 11<sup>th</sup>, 2020 planning commission meeting is cancelled.
