BENTON COUNTY HOUSEHOLDS MAY DELIVER ONLY ITEMS LISTED BELOW GENERATED FROM THEIR OWN HOUSEHOLD. Items must be delivered by a member of the household. GOVERNMENT-ISSUED PHOTO ID REQUIRED. Additional documentation may be required. Materials generated by a non-household OR suspected to be non-household material will NOT be accepted.

DISTRICT STAFF CANNOT HELP UNLOAD MATERIAL. BRING HELP IF NEEDED!

Household Furniture & Oversized (common household items that CANNOT fit inside a typical household trash container)	Up to 2 free items per month Additional items: \$10.00 each	Furniture, vacuum, large playground equipment, oversized toy, car seat, etc. No hot tubs! <u>Each individual mattress or box spring counts as 1 item.</u>
Non-refrigerated Large Appliances (See Electronics for Microwaves)	Free – no limit	Washer, dryer, range, dishwasher, water heater, etc. (Small appliances are not accepted and should be disposed in household trash.)
Metal Items - At least 90% metal by weight	Free – no limit	Grill, bicycle, metal table/chair, metal bed frame, etc. Eff 7/15/2021 – <u>NO METAL FENCING OR WIRES</u>
Household Hazardous Waste	See List on Back	Refer to the very strict limitations of material types and allowed volumes on other side of this flyer.
Household Electronics & Microwaves	\$5.00 each No Free Items	Must contain a circuit board and a power cord; Mouse, keyboard, speakers, cables accepted free.
Household Refrigerated Appliances (manufactured to contain refrigerant)	\$10.00 each No Free Items	Window air conditioner, dehumidifier, home ice maker, wine cooler, freezer, refrigerator. All food must be removed prior to delivery.
Tires from Households	Up to 4 tires free per month Add'l \$3.00 each	Tires of any size; 4 free per adult resident. More than 20 must be delivered to Centerton facility.

UNACCEPTABLE ITEMS:

- ⊘ NO non-household waste including from rental properties, farms, churches, schools, non-profits, businesses, agencies, etc.

- ⊘ NO delivery in Commercial Vehicles
- ⊘ NO Household trash or garbage
- ⊘ NO building materials of ANY kind
- ⊘ NO Yard waste, brush and leaves

PAYMENT OPTIONS

- **Personal Check** - ONLY with Government-issued Photo ID matching name on check and with Benton County Address
- **Credit or Debit Card** - ONLY with Government-issued Photo ID matching name on card. Processing fees will apply.
- **Cash** - exact change required. No change given! District will not be able to break your bills into smaller bills. (Consider purchasing a pre-paid Visa card from a local retailer. Processing fees will apply.)

FEES APPLY TO ALL VOLUMES OF THE FOLLOWING MATERIALS:

LATEX PAINT: Not hazardous. Dry it by mixing with kitty litter, shredded paper, soil or sawdust. Place open cans of dried paint in your regular trash. If generated by a household, the District will accept and dispose of this material for a fee of **\$2.00 per container up to 1-gallon capacity and \$10.00 per 5-gallon container.**

FERTILIZER: Should be used by the citizen on their property. If generated by a household, the District will accept and dispose of this material for a fee for **liquid of \$20.00 per gallon or a fee for Solid/Dry of \$13.00 per gallon volume.**

TAR AND SEALERS: Not common household materials. If generated by a household, the District will accept and dispose of this material for a fee of **\$8.00 per gallon volume in container.**
