Fire Hydrant Meter Service Contract

The undersigned, hereafter called Customer, requests the Siloam Springs Water Department, hereinafter called City, to furnish a fire hydrant meter as follows:

Customer agrees to pay \$600.00 deposit (refundable) plus a \$20.00 service charge (non-refundable), a connection fee of \$20.00 and a disconnection/reading fee of \$15.00 for this service, for a total of \$655.00 due with signed contract.

Table with 2 columns: Gallons, Rate. Rows include: First 1,000 gallons (\$20.00), Next 224,000 gallons (\$4.52 per 1,000), Next 125,000 gallons (\$4.07 per 1,000), Next 50,000 (\$3.39 per 1,000), Over 400,000 (\$2.37 per 1,000)

Additional charges:

A rental fee shall accrue at a rate of \$5.00 per day for the first 30 days the meter is in the customer's use or until the City is requested to remove the hydrant meter; whichever comes first. After a rental period of 30 days, the rental fee shall accrue at a rate of \$75.00 per month for any portion of a month the meter is used.

Customer is responsible for requesting the meter be removed. Removal requests made after 12:00 noon shall incur an additional day rental fee.

Reconnection fee: \$20.00 per locate. Reconnection fee shall accrue each time the Customer requests relocation of the hydrant meter.

Customer agrees to maintain the hydrant meter in reasonable condition and to safeguard the meter against damage or loss. Customer understands that tampering of any nature with a fire hydrant or meters is a violation of City of Siloam Springs Ordinance # 96.03. Customer agrees to pay for all damages to fire hydrant meter, brass valves, or hydrant associated with the use of the hydrant meter. Customer agrees not to operate fire hydrant nut or fire hydrant valve per Siloam Springs City Code, Standard Fire Prevention Code Book 1991, Chapter 6, Paragraph 602.5.2.

Customer Agrees to indemnify the City against all claims due to water pressure, purity, or volume, or due to damage to private or public property arising from the use of the fire hydrant meter.
